SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL - BOROUGH OF WAVERLEY

PROPOSED REVOCATION OF EXISTING, AMENDMENTS TO EXISTING AND PROVISION OF NEW WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND ON-STREET PARKING PLACES IN THE CRANLEIGH, HEATH END AND WEYBOURNE, FARNHAM, GODALMING, HASLEMERE, LOWER BOURNE, MILFORD AND WORMLEY AREAS

1. SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL ("THE COUNCIL") PROPOSE TO MAKE -
 - (a) The Surrey County Council ((Various Roads in Waverley) (Revocation and Consolidation of Waiting Loading and Unloading Prohibitions and Restrictions) Order 2007) (Amendment No.) Order 201- under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) and 4 (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act");
 - (b) The Surrey County Council ((Various Roads in Waverley) (Consolidation of Free Street Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. 1) Order 2007) (Amendment No.) Order 201- under Sections 32, 35 and 36 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act;
 - (c) The Surrey County Council ((Various Roads in Waverley) (Consolidation of Free Street Parking Places) Order 2007) (Amendment No.) Order 201- under Sections 32, 35 and 36 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act;
 - (d) The Surrey County Council (Farnham Railway Station Controlled Parking Zone (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) Order 2007) (Amendment No.) Order 201- under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) and 4 and 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 49, 51 and 53 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act;
 - (e) The Surrey County Council (Farnham Town Centre Controlled Parking Zone (Consolidation of Waiting Loading and Unloading Prohibitions and Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) Order 2007) (Amendment No.) Order 201- under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) and 4 and 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 49, 51 and 53 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act;

- (f) The Surrey County Council ((Various Roads in Waverley) (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) (No. 1) Order 2008) (Amendment No.) Order 201- under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act;
- (g) The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Waverley) (Residents' Only On-Street Parking Places) Order 201- under Sections 32, 35, 36 45, 46, 49, 51 and 53 of the 1984 Act;
- (h) The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Waverley) (Free On-Street Loading Bays) (No. 1) Order 201- under Sections 32, 35 and 36 of the 1984 Act; and
- (i) The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Waverley) (Pay and Display On-Street Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 201- under Sections 32, 35, 36 45, 46, 49, 51 and 53 of the 1984 Act.

2. The purpose and effect of The Surrey County Council ((Various Roads in Waverley) (Consolidation of Waiting Loading and Unloading Prohibitions and Restrictions) Order 2007) (Amendment No.) Order 201- will be to further amend The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Waverley) (Consolidation of Waiting Loading and Unloading Prohibitions and Restrictions) Order 2007 ("the No. 1 Order of 2007") so as to:-

- (a) revoke -
 - (i) any existing prohibition on the waiting by vehicles applying at any time of the day or night throughout the week in Church Road, Milford (fronting Nos. 12 to 26 Church Road), Kings Road, Haslemere (north side of the large island site fronting Nos. 119 to 147 Kings Road and fronting No. 111 Kings Road), Ockford Road, Godalming (fronting Nos. 104, 106 and 108 Ockford Road), St Christopher's Green (fronting Nos. 5 and 6 St Christopher's Green) and St James's Place Cranleigh (lying to the side of No. 268 High Street, Cranleigh and to the side of No. 250 High Street, Cranleigh);
 - (ii) the existing prohibition on the waiting by vehicles applying between 11.00 am and 12.00 midday on Mondays to Fridays (fronting the Garage and

- No. 101 Kings Road, Haslemere);
- (iii) any existing prohibition on the waiting by vehicles applying between 8.30 am and 6.30 pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive situated in Victoria Road, Cranleigh (fronting Nos. 1 to 9 (inclusive), Victoria Road);
 - (iv) the existing prohibition on the waiting by vehicles applying between 8.00 am and 6.00 pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive situated in St James' Avenue, Farnham (fronting Nos. 1 to 27 and the property known as "Bryeen Cottage" (part), St James' Avenue);
 - (v) the existing prohibition on the waiting by vehicles applying between 8.30 am and 6.30 pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in Church Road, Haslemere (fronting Nos. 24, 25 and 26 and Rosemary Court);
- (b) prohibit the waiting by vehicles at any time of the day or night throughout the week in the lengths of roads referred to in Schedule 1 to this Notice;
 - (c) prohibit the waiting by vehicles between 8.00 am and 6.00 pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in The Chantrys, Farnham (in the vicinity of its junction with West Street) ;
 - (d) prohibit the waiting by vehicles between 8.30 am and 6.30 pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in Farncombe Street, Farncombe (fronting Nos. 79, 81 and 83 Farncombe Street);
 - (e) prohibit the waiting by vehicles between 8 am and 6 pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in Arthur Road, Farnham (fronting Nos. 69 and 71 Arthur Road, No. 15 Arthur Close and No. 26 Arthur Close), Longley Road, Farnham (fronting No. 1 Longley Road) and Menin Way, Farnham (fronting Nos. 4, 6 and 8 Menin Way),
 - (f) convert the existing prohibition on waiting applying between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive to a prohibition on the waiting by vehicles applying at any time of the day or night throughout the week in Great Austins and Tilford Road, Farnham (at the junction of those roads with Menin Way);
 - (g) convert the existing prohibition on waiting applying between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive to a prohibition on the waiting by vehicles applying at

- any time of the day or night throughout the week in Menin Way, Farnham (fronting No. 51 Menin Way and the property known as “Willowdene”);
- (h) convert the existing prohibition on waiting applying between 7 a.m. and 10 a.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive to a prohibition on the waiting by vehicles applying at any time of the day or night throughout the week in New Road, Wormley (fronting and opposite the property known as “Gaddesden”);
 - (i) convert the existing prohibition on the waiting by vehicles applying between 11.00 am and 12.00 midday on Mondays to Fridays inclusive to a prohibition on the waiting by vehicles applying at any time of the day or night throughout the week in Kings Road, Haslemere (fronting No. 8);
 - (j) prohibit the waiting by vehicles between 11 a.m. and 2.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in Derby Road, Haslemere (fronting the properties known as “Highfield” and “Kylemore” and that length of the south-east side extending from the property boundary line between Rosemary Court and the property known as “Daybrook” and 10 metres south-west of High Lane);
 - (k) prohibit the waiting by vehicles between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in Church Road, Haslemere (that length lying on the north-east side of the property known as “Derby House”);
 - (l) prohibit the waiting by vehicles between 8.30 a.m. and 8.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in High Lane, Haslemere (in the vicinity of its junction with Weydown Road), Inval Hill, Haslemere (in the vicinity of its junction with Weydown Road), Kings Road, Haslemere (fronting Nos. 119 to 147 Kings Road) and Weydown Road, Haslemere (that length which extends from a point 30 metres north of its junction with Derby Road northwards to its junction with High Lane but excluding those lengths proposed to be designated as pay and display parking places or to become subject to a prohibition on the waiting by vehicles applying between 3.00 p.m. and 5.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive);
 - (m) prohibit the waiting by vehicles between 7 a.m. and 10 a.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in Combe Lane, Wormley (fronting the properties known as “May House”,

- “Springwood”, “Windrush” and “Little Woodlands” and that length lying between the southern property boundary line of the property known as “Gaddesden” and the property boundary line between the properties known as “Marsden” and “Zandra”);
- (n) prohibit the waiting by vehicles between 3 p.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in Weydown Road, Haslemere (fronting the properties known as “Riverdale” and “Wildwood”, that length fronting the property known as “Widford” and that length opposite the property known as “Ballindune”);
 - (o) with the exception of the lengths of West Street, Haslemere referred to in sub-paragraph (p) below and the lengths of Edward Road and Ridgway Road referred to in sub-paragraph (q) below, provide that in the lengths of roads described in paragraphs (b) to (n) inclusive above, the usual exemptions for loading and unloading vehicles, boarding and alighting from vehicles, using vehicles for works on or adjoining those lengths of roads, the maintenance of those roads and the services in them and for disabled persons’ vehicles in accordance with the “Blue Badge” Scheme would apply;
 - (p) prohibit the loading and unloading of vehicles at any time of the day or night throughout the week in the entire length of the south-west side of West Street, Haslemere with the exception of the lay-by proposed to be designated as a loading bay (see paragraph 9 below) and in the lay-by situated on the north-west side of High Street, Haslemere and fronting Nos. 1 to 4 Causewayside, High Street, Haslemere;
 - (q) prohibit the loading and unloading of vehicles applying between 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and 3 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in Edward Road and Ridgway Road, Farnham (at the junction of those two roads);
 - (r) in the lengths of High Street and West Street, Haslemere referred to in sub-paragraph (p) above and the lengths of Edward Road and Ridgway Road, Farnham referred to in sub-paragraph (q) above, the usual exemptions for boarding and alighting from vehicles, using vehicles for works on or adjoining those lengths of roads, the maintenance of those roads and the services in them would apply,

except in the case of Edward Road and Ridgway Road, Farnham where the exemptions in respect of the loading and unloading of vehicles and disabled persons' vehicles displaying a "Blue Badge" would apply outside of the hours specified in sub-paragraph (q) above.

3. The purpose and effect of The Surrey County Council ((Various Roads in Waverley) (Consolidation of Free Street Parking Places) Order 2007) (Amendment No.) Order 201- is to further amend The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Waverley) (Consolidation of Free Street Parking Places) Order 2007 ("the No. 2 Order of 2007") so as to -

- (a) revoke the designation by the No. 2 Order of 2007 of -
 - (i) all the existing free on-street parking places applying between 8.30 am and 6.30 pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, with waiting limited to a period of one hour, no return permitted within a further period of one hour, situated in Crownpits Lane, Godalming, High Street, Haslemere, Lion Green, Haslemere, Lion Lane, Haslemere, Shepherd's Hill, Haslemere, West Street, Haslemere and Wey Hill, Haslemere;
 - (ii) all the existing free on-street parking places applying between 8.30 am and 6.30 pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, with waiting limited to a period of one hour, no return permitted within a further period of two hours situated on the north-east side of King's Road, Haslemere;
 - (iii) that part of the existing free on-street parking place applying between 8.30 am and 6.30 pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, with waiting limited to a period of one hour, no return permitted within a further period of one hour, situated on the north-west side of Hare Lane, Farncombe fronting Nos. 26, 28, 30 and 32 Hare Lane, effectively splitting the existing free on-street parking place into two;
 - (iv) that part of the existing free on-street parking place applying between 8.30 am and 6.30 pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, with waiting limited to a period of one hour, no return permitted within a further period of one hour, situated on the south-east side of High Street, Cranleigh (fronting Nos.

212, 214 and 216 High Street), effectively shortening the existing free on-street parking place by 8 metres ;

- (b) designate as free on-street parking places the lengths of roads described in Part I, Part II, Part III and Part IV of Schedule 4 to this Notice;
- (c) provide that -
 - (i) the free on-street parking places described in Part I of Schedule 4 to this Notice will be in operation between 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
 - (ii) the free on-street parking place described in Part II of Schedule 4 to this Notice will be in operation between 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
 - (iii) the free on-street parking place described in Part III of Schedule 4 to this Notice will be in operation between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;
 - (iv) the free on-street parking places described in Part IV of Schedule 4 to this Notice will be in operation between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
- (d) specify that the vehicles which may be left in any of the free on-street parking places shall be passenger vehicles (8 seats or less), goods vehicles the maximum gross weight of which is less than 5 tonnes, motor-cycles and invalid carriages;
- (e) provide that -
 - (i) the period during which vehicles may be left in the free on-street parking places described in Part I of Schedule 4 to this Notice will be twenty minutes;
 - (ii) the period during which any vehicles may be left in any of the free on-street parking places described in Part II and Part IV of Schedule 4 to this Notice will be 4 hours;
 - (iii) the period during which vehicles may be left in the free on-street parking place described in Part III of Schedule 4 to this Notice will be one hour;
 - (iv) the period during which any vehicle may not return to the free on-street

parking place described in Part I, Part II and Part III of Schedule 4 to this Notice will be one hour;

- (v) the period during which any vehicle may not return to any of the free on-street parking places described in Part IV of Schedule 4 to this Notice will be 4 hours;
- (f) provide that vehicles left by specified disabled persons may wait in any of the free on-street parking places referred to above without time limit;
- (g) provide that certain other vehicles may wait in any of the free on-street parking places referred to above in certain circumstances (e.g., to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes), etc.; and
- (h) provide that outside the hours specified in sub-paragraph (c) above any vehicle may be left in any of the free parking places for any period without time limit.

4. The purpose and effect of The Surrey County Council ((Various Roads in Waverley) (Consolidation of Free Street Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. 1) Order 2007) (Amendment No.) Order 201- is to further amend The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Waverley) (Consolidation of Free Street Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. 1) Order 2007 (“the No. 3 Order of 2007”) so as to -

- (a) designate disabled persons’ free on-street parking places in Hallam Road, Godalming (that length fronting Nos. 1 and 3 Hallam Road), that length of St Christopher’s Road, Haslemere lying opposite the Haslemere Library and that length of Petworth Road, Haslemere (fronting Nos. 2/4, 6 and 8 Petworth Road);
- (b) provide that all the disabled persons’ free on-street parking places will operate at any time;
- (c) specify, in respect of all the disabled persons’ free on-street parking places, that only disabled persons’ vehicles displaying in the relevant position a disabled persons’ badge (commonly referred to as the “Blue Badge”) issued by any local authority under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 (S.I. 2000 No. 682) may be left in those parking places;
- (d) provide that, in respect of the disabled persons’ free on-street parking place in

Hallam Road, Godalming any disabled person's vehicle referred to in sub-paragraph (c) above may be left for any period without time limit free of charge and in respect of the disabled persons' free on-street parking places in St Christopher's Road and Petworth Road, Haslemere any disabled person's vehicle referred to in sub-paragraph (c) above may be left for a period of three hours, no return within a further period of one hour, also free of charge; and

- (e) provide that certain other vehicles may wait in the disabled persons' free on-street parking places in certain circumstances, e.g., to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes), etc.

5. The purpose and effect of The Surrey County Council (Farnham Town Centre Controlled Parking Zone (Consolidation of Waiting Loading and Unloading Prohibitions and Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) Order 2007) (Amendment No.) Order 201- will be to amend The Surrey County Council Farnham Town Centre Controlled Parking Zone (Consolidation of Waiting Loading and Unloading Prohibitions and Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) Order 2007 ("the No. 4 Order of 2007") so as to -

- (a) extend the area of the existing Farnham Town Centre Controlled Parking Zone ("CPZ") so as to include the entire lengths of Beaufort Road, Sumner Road, Thorold Road and Wykeham Road and the remaining lengths of Upper South View and St Cross Road currently outside that Zone within that Zone (NOTE – No resident of Sumner Court would qualify for the issue of a residents parking permit);
- (b) alter the hours of operation of the Farnham Town Centre CPZ so that it would apply on any day being Christmas Day, Good Friday and any day being a Bank Holiday (NOTE - All the other existing times within that Zone would remain unchanged, except as provided in paragraphs (h) to (k) and Schedule 3 (item No. 1) below [Castle Street only];
- (c) alter certain of the conditions of issue of residents parking permits so that the number of such parking permits that can be issued in respect of each residential property will be as set out in Schedule 2 to this Notice;
- (d) revoke all the existing shared-use on-street parking places situated in Castle Street

and certain lengths of the existing prohibition on the waiting by vehicles applying between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in certain lengths of Beaufort Road, Middle Church Road, Thorold Road and Upper South View, Farnham so as to permit the introduction of new shared-use on-street parking places (see subparagraphs (n) to (r) inclusive below);

- (e) prohibit the waiting by vehicles at any time of the day or night throughout the week in that length of Castle Street fronting Nos. 13 and 14 Castle Street, those lengths of Wykeham Road fronting Nos. 2 to 12 Wykeham Road and the northern end of the turning head in the vicinity of No. 29 Wykeham Road and Farnham Park and that length of Sumner Road fronting No. 1 Sumner Road;
- (f) prohibit the waiting by vehicles between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in those lengths of Sumner Road fronting Nos. 5 and 7 Sumner Road and adjacent to No. 21 Beaufort Road;
- (g) provide that in the lengths of roads described in paragraphs (e) and (f) above, the usual exemptions for loading and unloading vehicles, boarding and alighting from vehicles, using vehicles for works on or adjoining those lengths of roads, the maintenance of those roads and the services in them and for disabled persons' vehicles in accordance with the "Blue Badge" Scheme would apply;
- (h) designate as residents on-street parking places certain lengths of Castle Street, Farnham lying to the north-west of its junction with Park Row;
- (i) provide that all the residents on-street parking places will be in operation between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;
- (j) specify that the vehicles which may be left in any of the residents on-street parking places shall be vehicles displaying a valid residents parking permit bearing, inter alia, the letter "A" issued by the Guildford Borough Council (NOTE - vehicles left by specified disabled persons (i.e., those displaying a disabled person's "Blue Badge") may not be left in any of the residents on-street parking places situated within the Farnham Town Centre CPZ);

- (k) provide that certain other vehicles may wait in any of the residents on-street parking places situated within the Farnham Town Centre CPZ in certain circumstances, e.g., to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes), etc.;
- (l) convert certain of the existing shared-use on-street parking places to dual use on-street parking places in Castle Street (between its junctions with Park Row and The Borough), Falkner Road, Long Garden Way, The Hart and West Street, Farnham;
- (m) provide that the conditions of use and charges in respect of the use of the dual-use on-street parking places will be as set out in columns 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Schedule 3 to this Notice;
- (n) designate as shared-use on-street parking places certain lengths of Beaufort Road, Sumner Road, Middle Church Lane, Thorold Road, Upper South View and Wykeham Road, Farnham;
- (o) provide that all the shared use on-street parking places will be in operation between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;
- (p) specify that the vehicles which may be left in any of the shared use on-street parking places shall be passenger vehicles (8 seats or less), goods vehicles the maximum gross weight of which is less than 5 tonnes, motor-cycles and invalid carriages;
- (q) provide that -
 - (i) the period during which vehicles may be left in any of the shared-use on-street parking places will be 2 hours;
 - (ii) the period during which any vehicle may not return to any of the shared-use on-street parking places will be 1 hour;
- (r) provide that vehicles left by residents as defined in the No. 4 Order of 2007 displaying a valid resident's parking permit issued by Guildford Borough Council on behalf of the County Council would be exempt from the 2 hour (and/or any other time limit) in any of the shared-use on-street parking places situated within the Farnham Town Centre Controlled Parking Zone only;
- (s) provide that vehicles left by specified disabled persons may wait in any of the

shared-use on-street parking places situated within the Farnham Town Centre Controlled Parking Zone free of charge and without time limit;

- (t) provide that certain other vehicles may wait in any of the shared-use on-street parking places situated within the Farnham Town Centre Controlled Parking Zone in certain circumstances (e.g., to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes), etc.,;
- (u) provide that outside the hours specified in the third column of Schedule 3 to this Notice any vehicle may be left in any of the dual-use and residents on-street parking places and in sub-paragraph (o) above in respect of the shared use on-street parking places situated within the Farnham Town Centre Controlled Parking Zone free of charge and for any period without time limit;
- (v) introduce the facility to purchase a residents' visitor's parking permit in respect of the residents' only parking places situated in Castle Street and all the existing shared-use parking places situated within the Farnham Town Centre Controlled Parking Zone which will allow any resident as defined in the No. 4 Order of 2007 of any residential property situated in Castle Street or any other road or part of road situated within the aforesaid Controlled Parking Zone to apply for up to one hundred and twenty Visitor's Permits per annum at a cost of £2.00 for each Visitor's Permit (NOTE – in certain exceptional circumstances the number of Visitor's Permits issued in respect of each residential property could exceed the number of one hundred and twenty and there will be no upper limit on the number of Visitor Permits so issued, provided that the exceptional circumstances (referred to above) were met in each case).

6. The purpose and effect of The Surrey County Council (Farnham Railway Station Controlled Parking Zone (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) Order 2007) (Amendment No.) Order 201- is to further amend The Surrey County Council Farnham Railway Station Controlled Parking Zone (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) Order 2007 ("the No. 5 Order of 2007") so as to -
- (a) extend the area of the existing Farnham Railway Station Controlled Parking Zone

("CPZ") so as to include that length of Longley Road which extends from the north-eastern kerb-line of Tilford Road north-eastwards for a distance of 20 metres, that length of Morley Road which extends from the south-western kerb-line of Tilford Road south-westwards to the south-western kerb-line of St Georges Road and that length of Tilford Road which extends from a point 40 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line of Alfred Road south-eastwards to a point 20 metres north-west of the western kerb-line of Great Austins, Farnham within that Zone (NOTE – No resident of Longley Road and/or Morley Road would qualify for the issue of a residents parking permit due to the fact that no residential properties are situated within the lengths of these roads to be included within that Zone, except for No. 2 Morley Road as this property lies within the length of that road to be included within that Zone);

- (b) alter the hours of operation of the Farnham Railway Station CPZ so that it would apply on any day being Christmas Day, Good Friday and any day being a Bank Holiday (NOTE - All the other existing times within that Zone would remain unchanged);
- (c) revoke the existing shared use parking place situated in that length of Bridgefield fronting No. 2 Bridgefield and replace with a prohibition on the waiting by vehicles applying at any time of the day or night throughout the week (already signed as such on the ground);
- (d) revoke those lengths of the existing prohibition on the waiting by vehicles applying between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in that length of St Georges Road (fronting No. 6 St Georges Road) and that length of Tilford Road lying to the side of No. 1 Alfred Road so as to permit the introduction of new residents on-street parking places (see sub-paragraph (h) below);
- (e) to extend the existing prohibition on the waiting by vehicles applying at any time of the day or night throughout the week in Longley Road and Morley Road so that they would apply to the lengths of those roads to be included within the Farnham Railway Station CPZ, with the exception of a length of the south-east side of Morley Road

which is proposed to be designated as a residents on-street parking place (NOTE – any existing prohibition on the waiting by vehicles in the above-mentioned lengths of roads would be revoked);

- (f) prohibit the waiting by vehicles between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in that length of Tilford Road to be included within the Farnham Railway Station CPZ not to become designated as residents on-street parking places;
- (g) provide that in the lengths of roads described in sub-paragraphs (c), (e) and (f) above, the usual exemptions for loading and unloading vehicles, boarding and alighting from vehicles, using vehicles for works on or adjoining those lengths of roads, the maintenance of those roads and the services in them and for disabled persons' vehicles in accordance with the "Blue Badge" Scheme would apply;
- (h) designate as residents on-street parking places certain lengths of Morley Road, St Georges Road and Tilford Road, Farnham;
- (i) provide that all the residents on-street parking places will be in operation between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
- (j) specify that the vehicles which may be left in any of the residents on-street parking places shall be vehicles displaying a valid residents parking permit bearing, inter alia, the letter "B" issued by the Guildford Borough Council (NOTE - vehicles left by specified disabled persons (i.e., those displaying a disabled person's "Blue Badge") may not be left in any of the residents on-street parking places situated within the Farnham Railway Station CPZ;
- (k) provide that certain other vehicles may wait in any of the residents on-street parking places situated within the Farnham Railway Station CPZ in certain circumstances, e.g., to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes), etc.;
- (l) to increase the number of residents' visitor's parking permits issued to any resident as defined in the No. 5 Order of 2007 of any residential property situated in any road or part of a road situated within the Farnham Railway Station Controlled Parking Zone from up to thirty to up to one hundred and twenty Visitor's Permits per

annum at a cost of £2.00 for each Visitor's Permit (NOTE – in certain exceptional circumstances the number of Visitor's Permits issued in respect of each residential property could exceed the number of one hundred and twenty and there will be no upper limit on the number of Visitor Permits so issued, provided that the exceptional circumstances (referred to above) were met in each case);

- (m) designate a disabled persons' free on-street parking place in that length of Tilford Road fronting No. 62 Tilford Road;
- (n) provide that the disabled persons' free on-street parking place will operate at any time;
- (o) specify, in respect of the disabled persons' free on-street parking place, that only disabled persons' vehicles displaying in the relevant position a disabled persons' badge (commonly referred to as the "Blue Badge") issued by any local authority under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 (S.I. 2000/682) may be left for any period without time limit without charge;
- (p) provide that certain other vehicles may wait in the disabled persons' free on-street parking place in certain circumstances, e.g., to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes), etc.;
- (q) convert the existing shared-use parking place to a free on-street parking place situated in that that length of the south-east side of Alfred Road, Farnham fronting the playing field and lying adjacent to No. 41 Alfred Road;
- (r) provide that the free on-street parking place will be in operation between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
- (s) specify that the vehicles which may be left in the free on-street parking place shall be passenger vehicles (8 seats or less), goods vehicles the maximum gross weight of which is less than 5 tonnes, motor-cycles and invalid carriages and that such vehicles may be left free of charge and for any period without time limit;
- (t) provide that vehicles left by specified disabled persons (i.e., those displaying a disabled person's "Blue Badge") may also wait in the free on-street parking place

referred to above free of charge and without time limit;

- (u) provide that certain other vehicles may wait in the free on-street parking place referred to above in certain circumstances (e.g., to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes), etc.; and
- (v) provide that outside the hours specified in sub-paragraphs (i) and (r) above any vehicle may be left in any of the free and residents on-street parking places situated within the Farnham Railway Station CPZ free of charge and for any period without time limit.

7. The purpose and effect of The Surrey County Council ((Various Roads in Waverley) (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) (No. 1) Order 2008) (Amendment No.) Order 201- is to amend The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Waverley) (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) (No. 1) Order 2008 (“the Order of 2008”) so as to carry out a legal drafting amendment so as to re-position the existing “mandatory” School Keep Clear “Zig-Zag” marking situated in the south-east side of Weydon Lane, Farnham so as to reflect the actual position of this marking on the ground (marking provided in respect of the Pilgrims Way County Primary School).

8. The prohibition referred to in paragraph 7 above will not apply to -

- (a) any person causing or permitting a vehicle to stop or remain at rest -
 - (i) if that person is obliged to do so in order to avoid an accident;
 - (ii) if that person is required to do so by law;
- (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform;
- (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any prohibition, restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the road by or on behalf of the Surrey Police;
- (d) a vehicle which is displaying a valid waiver certificate issued by the Council or the Guildford Borough Council.

9. The purpose and effect of The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Waverley) (Free On-Street Loading Bays) (No. 1) Order 201- will be to designate an on-street loading

bay in the lay-by situated on the south side of West Street, Haslemere situated in the vicinity of Charter Walk and The Post Office -

- (a) provide that the loading bay will operate at any time;
- (b) specify, in respect of the on-street loading bay, that only vehicles actually in the process of loading goods on or unloading goods from that vehicle at adjoining premises may be left for any period without time limit and free of charge; and
- (c) provide that certain other vehicles may wait in the on-street loading bay in certain circumstances, e.g., in respect of any emergency vehicle (no time limit) and any vehicle displaying a Waiver Certificate issued by Guildford Borough Council (for the time period stated on the Certificate) , etc.

10. The purpose and effect of The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Waverley) (Pay and Display On-Street Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 201- will be to -

- (a) designate “pay and display” on-street parking places (controlled by ticket parking meters or a telephone payment system) on the roads or parts of roads specified in column 1 of Part I of Schedule 5 to this Notice at which charges may be made by the Council for vehicles authorised to be left in those parking places;
- (b) provide that the maximum period for which vehicles may wait and the interval before which vehicles may return, the charging hours and days and the rate of charge will be as set out in columns 2, 3 and 4 respectively of the said Part of the said Schedule;
- (c) provide that the vehicles which may be left in a “pay and display” on-street parking place shall be passenger vehicles (8 seats or less), goods vehicles under 5 tonnes maximum gross weight, motor cycles and invalid carriages;
- (d) provide that vehicles left by specified disabled persons (i.e., those displaying a disabled person’s “Blue Badge”) may also wait in any of the “pay and display” on-street parking places referred to above free of charge and without time limit;
- (e) provide that certain other vehicles may wait free of charge in any of the “pay and display” on-street parking places referred to above in certain circumstances (e.g., to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum

20 minutes), etc.

11. The purpose and effect of The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Waverley) (Residents Only On-Street Parking Places) Order 201- ("the Order of 201-") will be to -

- (a) designate residents' only on-street parking places on the roads or parts of roads specified in column 1 of Part II of Schedule 5 to this Notice at which charges may be made by the Council for vehicles authorised to be left in those parking places;
- (b) provide that the vehicles which may be left in a residents' only on-street parking place shall be passenger vehicles (8 seats or less), goods vehicles under 5 tonnes maximum gross weight and motor cycles displaying a residents parking permit;
- (c) provide that the charging hours and days, the residents parking permit identifier and the parking permit charge will be as set out in columns 2, 3 and 4 respectively of the said Part of the said Schedule;
- (d) provide that the residents' parking permits will be issued in accordance with the provisions specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice;
- (e) to issue residents' visitor's parking permits to any resident (as defined in the Order of 201-) of any residential property situated in any road or part of a road specified in Schedule 6 up to a maximum of one hundred and twenty Visitor's Permits per annum in respect of each residential property at a cost of £2.00 for each Visitor's Permit (NOTE – in certain exceptional circumstances the number of Visitor's Permits issued in respect of each residential property could exceed the number of one hundred and twenty and there will be no upper limit on the number of Visitor Permits so issued, provided that the exceptional circumstances (referred to above) were met in each case) -

(NOTE – The Parking Permit Identifier referred to in sub-paragraph (c) above indicates the roads where residents' only parking places are situated to which each visitors' parking permit bearing the letter indicated in column 3 of Part II of Schedule 5 to this Notice may be used. The roads to which each Identifier relates are specified in Schedule 6 to this Notice. There will be NO inter-availability for the use of the various visitors' parking permits whatsoever between the differently lettered areas);

- (f) provide that vehicles left by specified disabled persons (i.e., those displaying a disabled person's "Blue Badge") may also wait in any of the residents' only on-street parking places referred to above free of charge and without time limit;
- (g) provide that certain other vehicles may wait free of charge in any of the residents' only on-street parking places referred to above in certain circumstances (e.g., to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes), etc.;

(NOTE – The Parking Permit Identifier referred to in sub-paragraph (c) above indicates the roads where residents' only parking places are situated to which each residents' parking permit bearing the letter indicated in column 3 of Part II of Schedule 5 to this Notice may be used. The roads to which each Identifier relates are specified in Schedule 6 to this Notice. There will be NO inter-availability for the use of the various residents' parking permits whatsoever between the differently lettered areas).

12. The purpose and effect of each of the proposed Orders referred to in sub-paragraphs (a) to (f) inclusive of paragraph 1 above will be to carry out legal drafting amendments only to the No. 1 Order of 2007 (except as provided for in paragraph 2 above), the No. 2 Order of 2007 (except as provided for in paragraph 3 above), the No. 3 Order of 2007 (except as provided for in paragraph 4 above), the No. 4 Order of 2007 (except as provided for in paragraph 5 above), the No. 5 Order of 2007 (except as provided for in paragraph 6 above) and the Order of 2008 (except as provided for in paragraphs 7 and 8 above) which will not affect any of the measures introduced by any of those Orders.

13. A copy of each of the Orders, together with plans showing the lengths of roads to which those Orders relate, of each of the Orders specified in paragraph 12 (and the Orders which have amended those Orders) and of the Orders specified in sub-paragraphs (g), (h) and (i) of this Notice and a Statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Orders may be inspected, free of charge, from 13 January 2012 -

- (g) Bramley Library, High Street, Bramley, Tuesdays and Fridays 10am to 5pm, Thursdays 2pm to 5pm and Saturdays 10am to 4pm.

- (a) the north-west and west side, from a point 12 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of the access road leading to and from Moor Park Lane from the carriageway comprised in the Shepherd and Flock Roundabout south-westwards and then southwards for a distance of 105 metres;
- (b) the north-west and north side, from a point 6.5 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of the access road leading to and from Moor Park Lane from the carriageway comprised in the Shepherd and Flock Roundabout north-eastwards and then eastwards for a distance of 35 metres.
