Making Surrey a better place

From Monday 5 October 2009 you may be asked to prove you are a Surrey resident at your local recycling centre.

Why?

Surrey's recycling centres are provided for and paid for by residents in the 11 Surrey districts. By introducing this new scheme we can make sure that only Surrey residents with their own household waste can use the sites for **FREE**.

Do other councils do this?

Other councils have begun to charge, or stop Surrey residents using their sites. Surrey has been left with no other option but to do the same at certain sites.

The affected sites are:

- Bond Road, Warlingham
- Chaldon Road, Caterham
- Charlton Lane, Sunbury
- Blenheim Road, Epsom
- Swift Lane, Bagshot



What do I need to show to prove I am a resident?

Remember to bring one of the following - **driver's licence, council tax bill or a utility bill.**

What if I don't live in one of Surrey's 11 districts?
