

## NOTICE

### SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL - BOROUGH OF WAVERLEY

#### MODIFICATION TO THE PROPOSED REVOCATION OF EXISTING, AMENDMENTS TO EXISTING AND PROVISION OF NEW WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND ON-STREET PARKING PLACES IN THE CRANLEIGH, HEATH END AND WEYBOURNE, FARNHAM, GODALMING, HASLEMERE, LOWER BOURNE, MILFORD AND WORMLEY AREAS

1. ON FRIDAY 13 JANUARY 2012 SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL ("THE COUNCIL") GAVE NOTICE IN THE FARNHAM HERALD AND THE HASLEMERE HERALD (ON PAGE 17) AND IN THE SURREY ADVERTISER (ON PAGE 5 OF THE CLASSIFIED SECTION) THAT THE COUNCIL PROPOSED TO MAKE, inter alia, The Surrey County Council (Farnham Railway Station Controlled Parking Zone (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) Order 2007) (Amendment No. ) Order 201-, The Surrey County Council (Farnham Town Centre Controlled Parking Zone) (Consolidation of Waiting Loading and Unloading Prohibitions and Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) Order 2007) (Amendment No. ) Order 201-, The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Waverley) (Pay and Display On-Street Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 201- and The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Waverley) (Residents' Only On-Street Parking Places) Order 201- under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) and 4 and 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 49, 51 and 53 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, the general purpose and effect of which was to propose to make amendments to and to revoke certain of the existing waiting restrictions and to provide new and additional waiting restrictions and residents' only, shared-use, dual-use and free on-street parking places in the Cranleigh, Farnham and Haslemere areas.

2. THE COUNCIL NOW GIVES NOTICE THAT it proposes to make the Orders with the further modifications described in this Notice.

3. These further modifications are to:-

(a) introduce a facility to issue -

- (i) Operational Parking Permits which would be issued free of charge for a period of twelve months to doctors, nurses, healthcare and community visitors and other categories of medical personnel operating through Surrey County Council or the National Health Service or private healthcare organisations who make house visits; or
- (ii) Carers Parking Permits which would be issued at a cost of £10 for a period of up to twelve months to housebound residents situated within the Farnham Railway Station or Town Centre Controlled Parking Zones or the six proposed Resident Parking Permit Areas in Cranleigh and Haslemere who require regular short term visits from carers or community care personnel in order to carry out carer's duties,

to enable those persons' or any carer visiting a housebound resident to leave their vehicles in any shared-use, dual-use and residents only on-street parking places situated within the Farnham Town Centre Controlled Parking Zone, in any shared-use and residents only on-street parking places situated in the Farnham Railway Station Controlled Parking Zone and the proposed

residents only on-street parking places situated in certain roads in the Cranleigh and Haslemere areas whilst carrying out the duties listed in subparagraphs (i) and (ii) above (NOTE – The Carer’s Parking Permits will only be valid in the Zone or Residents Area in which the housebound resident actually resides);

- (b) in respect of the proposed “pay and display” on-street parking places -
  - (i) to designate such parking places in certain lengths of Beech Road, Haslemere operating between 8.30 a.m. and 8 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive with no time limit on the period that any vehicle may be left in those parking places and with a rate of charge of £1 per hour for a period of up to five hours and thereafter a flat rate charge of £5 for any further period;
  - (ii) situated in Church Road, Courts Hill Road, Derby Road, Kings Road, Tanners Lane and Weydown Road, Haslemere, to provide that all those parking places would operate between 8.30 a.m. and 8 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive with no time limit on the period that any vehicle may be left in those parking places and with a rate of charge of £1 per hour for a period of up to five hours and thereafter a flat rate charge of £5 for any further period;
  - (iii) situated in Bunch Lane, Lion Lane and St Christopher’s Green, Haslemere operating between 8.30 a.m. and 8 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive with no time limit on the period that any vehicle may be left in those parking places and with a rate of charge of £1 per hour for a period of up to five hours and thereafter a flat rate charge of £5 for any further period;
- (c) in respect of the proposed residents’ only on-street parking places to be situated in Beech Road, Haslemere to provide that all those parking places in that road would operate between 8.30 a.m. and 8 p.m. on any day of the week, the Parking Permit Identifier would be the letter “E” and that the Parking Permit Charge would be £50 for the first residents permit and £75 for the second residents permit which would both be valid for a period of 12 months;
- (d) in respect of the Residents Parking Permit Area E (consisting of all residential properties situated in Beech Road, Bridge Road, Chestnut Avenue, Church Green, Popes Mead, Tanners Lane and West Street, Haslemere, to provide that, in respect of West Street, Haslemere, only those properties numbered 27 and 48 to 56 (even numbers only) would be able to apply for residents’ and visitors’ permits for that Residents Parking Area).

There would be no other changes to the conditions of issue of residents’ parking permits and to the time limits, conditions of use and classes of vehicles that may use the proposed dual-use and the existing residents and shared-use parking places within the Farnham Railway Station or Farnham Town Centre Controlled Parking Zones or the proposed residents parking places within the six proposed Residents Parking Permit Areas situated in the Cranleigh and Haslemere areas.

- 4. A copy of the Traffic Regulation Orders to which these proposed modifications apply and a Statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the modified Orders may be inspected, free of charge, at -

- (a) Waverley Borough Council, The Burys, Godalming, Mondays to Fridays 8.45am to 4.45pm;
- (b) Farnham Locality Office, South Street, Farnham, during normal hours on Mondays to Fridays;
- (c) Farnham Library, Vernon House, 28 West Street, Farnham, Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays 9am to 6pm, Tuesdays and Thursdays 9am to 7pm and Saturdays 9am to 5pm;
- (d) Cranleigh library, High Street, Cranleigh, Tuesdays 9am to 7pm, Wednesdays, Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays 9am to 5pm;
- (e) Haslemere Library, 91 Weyhill, Haslemere, Tuesdays 9am to 7pm, Wednesdays, Thursdays Fridays and Saturdays 9am to 5pm;
- (f) Godalming Library, Bridge Street, Godalming, Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays 9am to 6pm, Tuesdays and Thursdays 9am to 7pm and Saturdays 9am to 5pm; and
- (g) Bramley Library, High Street, Bramley, Tuesdays and Fridays 10am to 5pm, Thursdays 2pm to 5pm and Saturdays 10am to 4pm.
