

## Community Recycling Centre (CRC) charging waste scheme

Surrey County Council (SCC) charges for the disposal of some non-household waste materials at its CRCs. The charges are for:

- Waste from the construction, alteration or repair of homes and gardens (including plasterboard).
- Tyres from cars, motorcycles and all other motorised vehicles (including non-motorised vehicles and trailers pulled by a motorised vehicle).

The table below is a list of waste materials with guidance on how to dispose of them. Details on charges for waste materials is included further on in this document.

\*Vans, pick-ups and trailers bringing waste that is accepted at our CRCs are still required to have a [valid van permit](#).

All other types of non-household waste that aren't on the above list are accepted free of charge in a car, van, pick-up or trailer.

Waste that is charged for at our CRCs should be brought to the site in appropriately sized bags (no bigger than 50x77cm). Items such as sheets of plasterboard and sinks that don't fit into bags will be priced per item. If waste that is charged for is brought to a site loose in the back of a car then it will be charged at a rate of £50 per car.

The table below details how much is charged for different types of waste.

<p><b>£5 charge per tyre or part tyre</b> from motorised vehicles (including non-motorised vehicles and trailers pulled by a motorised vehicle)</p>	

**Please note:**

\*Asbestos must not be disposed of with any of the above materials. For advice on safe disposal of asbestos please visit the [asbestos pages on the SCC website](#).

\*\*Only cured (set) cement accepted.

\*\*\*Plasterboard must be disposed of in the dedicated plasterboard container.

All of the charges listed above are inclusive of VAT.

The decision of site staff is final.

Payment can only be made by Visa or MasterCard debit and credit cards. Cash, cheques and other credit cards such as American Express or Diners Club cannot be accepted. Payment will need to be made to the Charging Scheme Officer at the site entrance before you are given access to the chargeable containers.

For large home renovation projects please consider factoring in the cost of hiring a skip or using a commercial waste contractor to dispose of your waste. Our sites are not designed to accept large quantities of this type of waste.

It is important to always check that any contractor you hire to dispose of your waste is a [registered waste carrier](#).

If you bring **any** type of waste arising from the construction, alteration or repair of your home or garden to one of our CRCs in a **van, pick-up or trailer** you will be redirected to a [waste transfer station](#) where your waste will be weighed and charged for at rate per tonne depending on the type of material.

Where charges are applicable, payment must be made to a Charging Scheme Officer at the entrance prior to the customer being granted access to the chargeable containers to tip their waste. Charges are non-negotiable and the decision of the site staff is final.
