Woodmansterne Street (D1072) Woodmansterne
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 30 June 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Woodmansterne Street (D1072) Woodmansterne as extends from its junction with (D1072) Court Haw to its junction with (D1071) Kingscroft Road. The alternative route will be via Woodmansterne Lane; Longcroft Avenue; A2022 Croydon Lane; and Carshalton Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate safe access to overhead telecoms structures and/or new customer connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 9.30am and 3.30pm in within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 13 July 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for residents and the emergency services, pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.
