Godstone Road (A22) Whyteleaf
Temporary Prohibition of Right Turn Order 2021

On 07 July 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles that are travelling north westwards on (A22) Godstone Road from turning right into (D1389) Well Farm Road.

This Temporary Traffic Order is required to allow electrical works to be carried out by, or on behalf of UK Power Solutions. These works are anticipated to be carried out within 2 weeks of the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 09 August 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary prohibitions, which are anticipated to be in force 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for all traffic will be via the signed vehicular diversion route which will A22 Godstone Road (Northbound); Hillbury road and Whyteleaf Hill Roundabout; A22 Godstone Road (Southbound); Left turn into Well Farm Road.
