Markwick Lane (C32) Loxhill
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 13 October 2021 Surrey County Council made Surrey County Council Propose to Make the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Markwick Lane (C32) Loxhill as extends from Its junction with (D170) Mare Lane to its junction with Public Bridleway No. 189 Hambledon.

Alternative Route – Markwick Lane; Godalming Road; The Street; Hascombe Road; Brighton Road; A3100 Flambard Way / Ockford Road / Portsmouth Road; Station Lane; Salt Lane; and Hydon Heath or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate telecoms poletest works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 9.30am and 3.30pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 24 October 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained by the crew as and when it is required, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
