Three Gates Lane (D5528) Haslemere
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order (No.2) 2021

On 10 November 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and 14(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to –

- (a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Three Gates Lane (D5528) Haslemere as extends from its junction with (A246) High Street to its with (D5528) Highercombe Road; and
- (b) suspend “The Surrey County Council Three Gates Lane (D5528) Haslemere Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021” only insofar as it affects the length of road specified in part (a) to this Notice.

Alternative Route – A286 High Street / Grayswood Road; and Highercombe Road.

The Order is required to facilitate new telecoms fibre connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 days between the hours of 9.30am and 3.30pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 17 November 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times via assistance from a Traffic Marshall, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists.
