**Snowdenham Lane (C31) Bramley**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order (No.2) 2021**

On 08 December 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Snowdenham Lane (C31) Bramley as extends from its junction with (C31) Iron Lane to its junction with Public Footpath No.475a Bramley.

The alternative route will be via Snowdenham Lane; A281 Horsham Road; Foxburrow Hill Road; and Iron Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate new telecoms fibre connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 9.30am and 3.30pm within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 14 December 2021. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be provided by Marshalls if required. All other traffic will be required to follow the diversion routes listed above.
