Shawfield Road (B3206) Ash
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 21 December 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Shawfield Road (B3206) Ash that is crossed by the rail over road bridge and for a distance of 20 metres on either side.

Alternative Route - Shawfield Road; Ash Hill Road; and A323 Guildford Road/Ash Church Road/Ash Street or this same route in reverse. The Order is required to facilitate bridge examination and/or maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Network Rail within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 night between the hours of 9pm and 5am within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 06 January 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for the Emergency Services will be maintained at all times. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be provided by Marshalls if required. All other traffic will be required to follow the diversion routes listed above.
