Prestwick Lane (D154) Chiddingfold
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 22 December 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Prestwick Lane (D154) Chiddingfold as extends from its junction with (D153) Combe Lane to a point approximately 240 metres south and west of its junction with (D157) Pook Hill.

The alternative route will be via Prestwick Lane; Clammer Hill Road; Holdfast Lane; Petworth Road; Killinghurst Lane; A283 Petworth Road; Woodside Road; and Combe Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate essential water mains replacement works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Thames Water and/or JBrowne Construction within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 months between the hours of 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday; and 8am and 4pm on Saturdays within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 05 January 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times via road plates. Access for pedestrians, dismounted cyclists, and equestrians will be provided by Marshalls if required. All other traffic will be required to follow the diversion routes listed above.
