**The Surrey County Council**  
**Upper Gordon Road (D3528) Camberley**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022**

On 18 January 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Upper Gordon Road (D3528) Camberley as extends from a point in line with the northern boundary of No.4 Upper Gordon Road to a point in line with the south western boundary of No.12 Upper Gordon Road.

Alternative Route – Upper Gordon Road; West Road; Upper Park Road; and Upper Gordon Road.

The Order is required to facilitate telecoms pole replacement works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 9.30am and 3.30pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 21 January 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. Access to premises within the affected length of road and (D3529) Barns Close, including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained by the crew as needed.
