**Station Avenue (C155) Walton On Thames**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022**

On 26 January 2022 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Station Avenue (C155) Walton On Thames as extends from its junction with (A244) Hersham Road south westwards for a distance of approximately 30 metres.

Alternative Route – Station Avenue; Ashley Road; Stompond Lane; and A244 Hersham Road or this same route in reverse.

This Order, which will commence on 07 February 2022 for a period of 12 months is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said roads, to be carried out by or on behalf of Surrey County Council, including but not limited to: traffic signal maintenance and/or repair and/or upgrade works. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 19 days between the hours of 8am and 6pm Monday to Friday, and 8am and 3pm on weekends.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Due to the nature of the works and for reasons of safety there will be no access through the works area, all traffic will be required to use the diversion route listed above. No sole access will be affected.
