**Foxhills Road (D3046) Chertsey**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022**

On 09 February 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Foxhills Road (D3046) Chertsey as extends from its junction with (D3047) Tringham Close to its junction with (D3047) Cottage Close.

Alternative Route - Foxhills Road; A319 Chobham Road/Chertsey Road; Old Chertsey Road; and Stonehill Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate gas mains replacement works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Cadent Gas within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 weeks between the hours of 8am and 5pm within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 14 February 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
