**The Surrey County Council**  
**St Johns Road (D7309) Woking**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022**

On 09 February 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding the entire length of St Johns Road (D7309) Woking.

Alternative Route – St Johns Road; Hermitage Road; A324 Amstel Way/Lockfield Drive; and Parley Drive or this same route in reverse.

This Order, which will commence on 14 February 2022 for a period of 18 months is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said roads, to be carried out by or on behalf of Surrey County Council, including but not limited to: pedestrian refuge construction and/or highway maintenance works.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Any vehicle found to be obstructing the highway during these works will be removed to outside the limits of the works after all reasonable methods have been undertaken to identify and contact the vehicle's owner.

Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times, as will access for emergency service vehicles in an emergency situation only. Vehicular access for residents and businesses will be maintained only when safe to do so, if necessary, via the diversion route.

During certain phases of the works, vehicular access to premises may be restricted, when this is the case such restriction of access will apply for no more than eight hours within any 24-hour period.
