**The Surrey County Council**  
**Ashley Road (B365) Walton on Thames**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022**

On 23 February 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Ashley Road (B365) Walton on Thames as extends from its junction with (A244) Ashley Road to its junction at the roundabout with Stompond Lane/Ashley Park Road/Ashley Park Avenue.

Alternative Route – (A244) Ashley Road/Hersham Road; and Stompond Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate new electrical connection works for Shepperton Studio's to be carried out by, or on behalf of Dunamis within the lengths of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 month between the hours of 8am and 6pm within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 28 February 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closures and prohibitions, which are anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
