**The Surrey County Council**  
**Various Roads in Waverley**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022**

On 20 July 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

This Order, which will commence on 27 July 2022 for a period of 18 months is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said roads, to be carried out by or on behalf of Surrey County Council, including but not limited to: carriageway patching and/or carriageway surface dressing and/or carriageway resurfacing and/or major highway maintenance works. Advanced warning signs will be displayed; and the temporary closures and suspensions will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Any vehicle found to be obstructing the highway during these works will be removed to outside the limits of the works after all reasonable methods have been undertaken to identify and contact the vehicle's owner.

Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times, as will access for emergency service vehicles in an emergency situation only. Vehicular access for residents and businesses will be maintained only when safe to do so, if necessary, via the diversion route. During certain phases of the works, vehicular access to premises may be restricted, when this is the case such restriction of access will apply for no more than eight hours within any 24-hour period.

**Schedule**

- (a) that length of Farnborough Road (A325) Farnham as extends from its junction with (A3016) Upper Hale Road to the Surrey County Council boundary with Hampshire County Council.  
Alternative Route: A325 Farnborough Road; A3011 Lynchford Road; A331 Blackwater Valley Road; A31 Runfold Diversion/Shepherd & Flock R/A; And A325 Farnborough Road/Hale Road;
- (b) that length of Plaistow Road (C33) Dunsfold as extends from its junction with (C33) Wrotham Hill/Chiddingfold Road to its junction with (D161) Fisher Lane.

Alternative Route: Wrotham Hill; Common House Road; Alfold Road; Dunsfold Road; Loxwood Road; Guildford Road; High Street; Plaistow Road; Loxwood Road; and Dunsfold Road;

- (c) that length of High Pittfold (D5507) Hindhead as extends from its junction with (D5507) Hazel Grove and (D5507) Glen Lea to its junction with (D5507) Old Bramshott Chase.

Alternative Route: Glen Lea; Nutcombe Lane; A287 Hindhead Road; Critchmere Hill; Woolmer Hill Road; Upper Hammer Lane; Little Hammer Lane; and Old Bramshott Chase;

- (d) that length of West End Lane (D116) Frensham as extends from its junction with (D117) Boundary Road to its junction with (D118) Summer Hill Lane. Alternative Route: Summer Hill Lane; Woodhill Lane; and Boundary Road; and

- (e) that length of Weybourne Road (B3007) Farnham as extends from its junction with (B3367) Monkton Lane to the Surrey County Council boundary with Hampshire County Council.

Alternative Routes – Clockwise: Weybourne Road; Eggars Hill; Grosvenor Road; Queens Road; Lime Street; Oberursel Way; A323 Wellington Avenue/High Street/Ash Road; Lower Farnham Road; Badshot Lea Road; Monkton Lane; Anticlockwise: Monkton Lane; Monkton Lane; Badshot Lea Road; Lower Farnham Road; A323 Ash Road/High Street/Wellington Avenue; Princes Way; Grosvenor Road; Eggars Hill; Weybourne Road.
