Summer Road (D6914) East Molesey
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

Surrey County Council propose to make the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit any person from entering or proceeding on foot or by any other means in that length of the Summer Road (D6914) East Molesey footbridge/footpath as extends from its junction with (D6914) Summer Gardens to its junction with (X16409) Molemer Road.

Alternative Route – Summer road; A309 Hampton Court Way; Embercourt Road; Ember Lane; Esher Road; and Summer Road.

This Order, which will commence on 01 September 2022 for a maximum period of 18 months is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said roads, to be carried out by or on behalf of Surrey County Council, including but not limited to: footbridge expansion joint replacement and/or steel parapet painting and/or footbridge/footpath maintenance works. These works are anticipated to be completed between the hours of 7.30am and 6pm. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Due to the nature of the works, there will be no access across the footbridge and along the footpath whilst works are in progress. Access for pedestrians, the emergency services and cyclists will be maintained via the diversion route above. No sole access will be affected.
