D230 Hoe Lane, Abinger Hammer
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 16 November 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of D230 Hoe Lane, Abinger Hammer that extends from its junction with Westfield, for a distance of 50m in both directions.

This Traffic Order is required to enable Morrison Utility Services to carry out water mains connection and/or maintenance works on behalf of Thames Water/Agility Alliance. These works are anticipated to be carried out within 4 days of the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 21 November 2022. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure which is anticipated to be required for 24 hours each day will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

No sole access will be affected. Access for emergency services, pedestrians, cyclists, and equestrians will be maintained at all times. The vehicular diversion route will be via Hoe Lane, Pursers Lane, Peaslake Lane, Radnor Road, Radnor Lane, Holmbury Hill Road, and Horsham Road.
