The Surrey County Council D3060 Junewood Close, Woodham Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 11 January 2023 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in the entire length of D3060 Junewood Close, Woodham. Access for emergency services, pedestrians and, dismounted cyclists and equestrians will be maintained at all times. There is no applicable alternative route for traffic however access for residents and businesses will be maintained under direction of site operatives. Any vehicle found to be obstructing the highway during these works will be removed to a suitable location outside the limits of the works after all reasonable methods have been undertaken to identify and contact the vehicle's owner.
