Parvis Road (A245) West Byfleet
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 25 January 2023 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Parvis Road (A245) West Byfleet which extends from its junction with (D3758) Dartnell Avenue to its junction with (D3761) Queens Avenue. Alternative Route – Parvis Road, Old Woking Road, Sheerwater Road, Woodham Lane, (A320) Chertsey Road, (A320) Guildford Road, (A320) St Peters Way, (A320) Chertsey Road, (A318) Brighton Road, (A318) New Haw Road, (A318) Byfleet Road, (A318) Barnes Wallis Drive, (A318) Sopwith Drive and Parvis Road or this route in reverse. This Order is required to facilitate drainage investigation works by or on behalf of Octavius Infrastructure. These works are anticipated to be completed within 6 nights between 9pm and 6am during the 12 month period of operation of this Order which will commence on 30 January 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for emergency services and pedestrians will be maintained via the operatives on site. All other traffic will be required to follow the alternative route described above.
