Drummond Road (D4005) Guildford
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 25 January 2023 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Drummond Road (D4005) Guildford which extends from its point in line with the western boundary of No.51 Drummond Road to its junction with (D4005) Park Road. There is no alternative diversion for this route. This Order is required to facilitate installation of electrical cable works by or on behalf of ALS Civil. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 5 days between the hours of 8am and 6pm, during the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 30 January 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in force 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road, including access by emergency service vehicles to these properties, will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
