B2128 Horsham Road, D922 Service Road of Horsham Road
and D186 Avenue Road, Cranleigh
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 08 February 2023 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of: -

- (a) B2128 Horsham Road, Cranleigh that extends from the southern side of its junction with D922 Ashtrees, to the northern side of its junction with D186 Grove Road.
- (b) D186 Avenue Road, Cranleigh that extends from its junction with B2128 Horsham Road, for a distance of 100m.
- (c) D922 Service Road of Horsham Road, Cranleigh that extends from its western junction with B2128 Horsham Road, to its junction with the access road to "Selham Lodge".

This Traffic Order is required to enable Morrison Utility Services to carry out water mains replacement and/or maintenance works on behalf of Thames Water. These works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 7am and 7pm within 15 weeks of the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 15 February 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure which is anticipated will be required for 24 hours each day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access for emergency services, residents, businesses, pedestrians, cyclists, and equestrians will be maintained at all times.

Alternative routes: - For B2128 Horsham Road and D186 Avenue Road via Bookhurst Road, Cranleigh Road, The Green, Somersbury Lane and Horsham Road. For D922 Service Road of Horsham Road via Horsham Road B2128.
