D3272 Woodlands Parade, Ashford
Temporary Traffic Management Order 2023

On 15 March 2023 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to: - 1. Prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of D3272 Woodlands Parade, Ashford that extends from its northern junction with D3272 Hogarth Avenue, to the south-western property boundary of "No. 9-10 Woodlands Parade". 2. Suspend in its entirety the "UD Staines (Woodlands Parade Ashford) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1968" that imposes the existing one-way system in D3272 Woodlands Parade, Ashford. This Traffic Order is required by Centurion Traffic Management to enable the installation of telecoms and/or maintenance works near to the north-western property boundary of "No. 12 Woodlands Parade". These works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 8am and 6pm within 4 days of the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 20 March 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure and suspension will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians and, dismounted cyclists and equestrians will be maintained at all times. No sole access to any property will be affected. Access for residents, businesses and emergency services will be maintained via the southern junction of D3272 Hogarth Avenue with D3272 Woodlands Parade.
