Highclere Road (D3620) Woking
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 22 March 2023 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Highclere Road (D3620) Woking as extends from its junction with (C12) High Street to its junction with (D3621) Highclere Gardens. Alternative route - Highclere Gardens, and High Street.

This Order which will commence on 31 March 2023 for a period of 18 months is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said roads, to be carried out by or on behalf of Surrey County Council, including but not limited to: providing a safe works zone, parking and storage for the works being carried out at the junction of (D3620) Highclere Road, (C12) High Street/Anchor Hill and (D3605) Lower Guildford Road. These works are anticipated to be completed within 18 days, between the hours of 8am and 10pm.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access will be maintained for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians, dismounted cyclists and businesses. All other traffic will be required to follow the alternative route described above. The Council are satisfied that, in accordance with Section 3(2)(a) and 3(2)(b) of the Act, vehicular access to and from premises within the length of road above, or accessible only therefrom, may be restricted in order to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road and/or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
