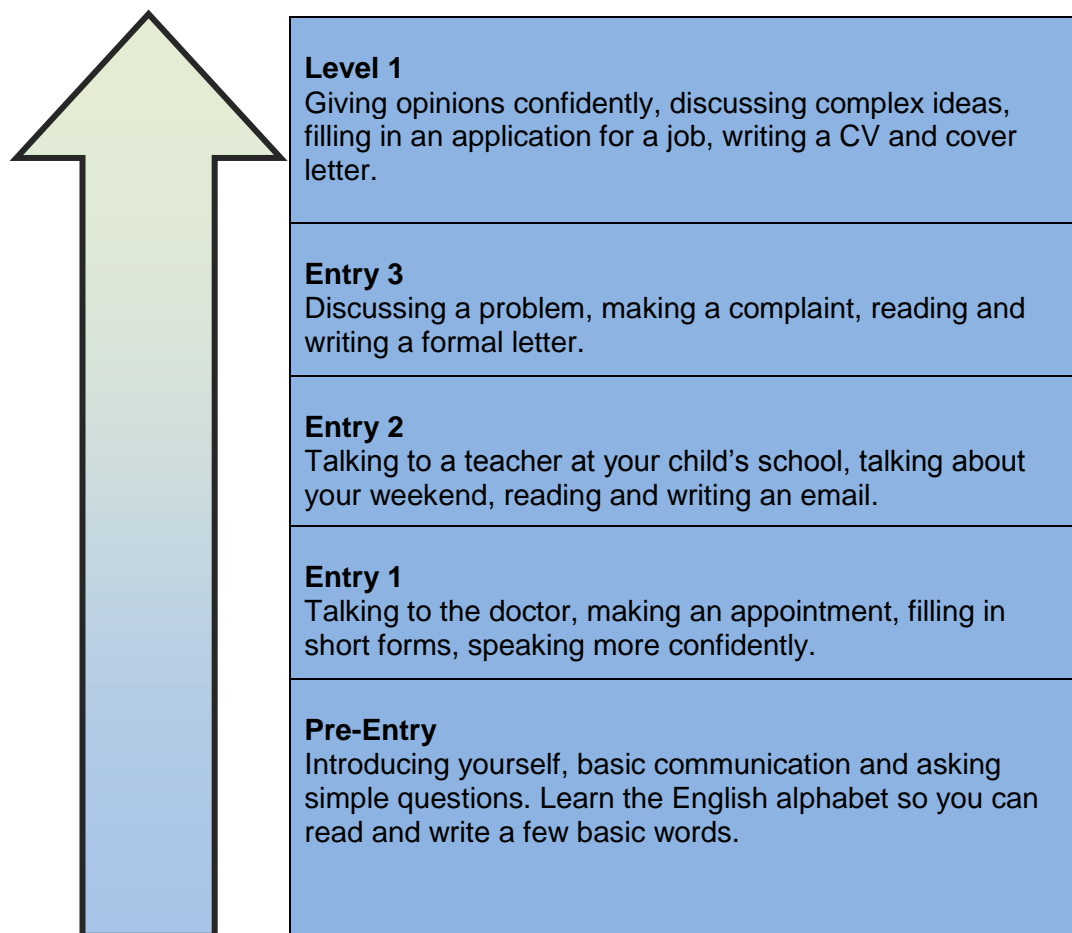
Surrey County Council's Adult Learning service offers a range of ESOL courses suitable for learners staying in the UK looking to improve their English language skills and gain a qualification.
