

Surrey County Council
Amendments to Waiting and Parking Restrictions
in the District of Tandridge

On 20 August 2020 Surrey County Council proposed to make under Sections 1(1), 2 (1) to (3), 4(2), 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 51, 52 and 53 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), certain amendments to the waiting and parking restrictions in the District of Tandridge. It is now proposed to make further amendments to these proposals as detailed below:-

1. “The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Tandridge) (Revocation and Consolidation of Waiting Loading and Unloading Prohibitions and Restrictions) Order 2006 (Amendment No. 11) Order 202-” which will amend “The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Tandridge) (Revocation and Consolidation of Waiting Loading and Unloading Prohibitions and Restrictions) Order 2006”, so as to:
 - (a) prohibit the waiting by vehicles in certain lengths of the roads specified in **Schedule 1** to this Notice on the days and during the times specified in the said Schedule provide that the following exemptions shall apply –
 - (i) for loading on and unloading from vehicles;
 - (ii) boarding and alighting from vehicles;
 - (iii) using vehicles for works on or adjoining those lengths of roads specified and the maintenance of those roads and the services in them;
 - (iv) provide that exemptions for disabled persons vehicles in accordance with the “Blue Badge” scheme shall also apply;
 - (b) revoke the existing “at any time” restriction in a certain length of **Godstone Road, Whyteleaf**, without replacement.
2. “The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Tandridge) (Consolidation of Free Street parking Places and Revocation) Order 2006 (Amendment No. 11) Order 202-” which will amend “The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Tandridge) (Consolidation of Free Street parking Places and Revocation) Order 2006”, so as to:

(a) provide such free on-street parking places in a certain length of **High Street, Godstone**, to operate Monday to Saturday (inclusive) applying between 8.30am-6pm 1 hour no return within 1 hour with the following provisions –

- (i) specify that the vehicles which may be left shall be passenger vehicles (8 seats or less), motor cycles, invalid carriages and goods vehicles under 5 tonnes maximum gross weight;
- (ii) provide that between the permitted hours the period during which vehicles may be left and the period during which any vehicle may not return to any of the said free on-street parking places will be as specified above;
- (iii) provide that vehicles left by specified disabled persons may wait at all times without time limit;
- (iv) provide that certain other vehicles may wait in certain circumstances e.g. to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes) to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes), etc;
- (v) provide that outside the hours of operation indicated any vehicle may be left in any of those free on-street parking places for any period without time limit;

(b) revoke the existing free on-street parking place in a certain length of **High Street, Godstone**, operating Monday to Saturday 8.30am-6pm 1 hour no return within 1 hour without replacement.

3. “The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Tandridge) (Consolidation of Free Street Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. 1) Order 2006 (Amendment No. 11) Order 202-” which will amend “The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Tandridge) (Consolidation of Free Street Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. 1) Order 2006” so as to provide such free disabled persons on-street parking places in the lengths of roads specified in **Schedule 2** to this Notice. Such provisions as specified in sub-paragraph 2(a)(iv) shall also apply.

4. "The Surrey County Council Various Roads in the District of Tandridge (Residents' On-Street Parking Places) Order 2019 (Amendment No. 3) Order 202-", which will amend "The Surrey County Council Various Roads in the District of Tandridge (Residents' On-Street Parking Places) Order 2019" so as to include property **Nos. 111-119 Station Road East, Oxted (odd numbers only)** to be eligible to apply for permits in Resident Area "E", with the following provisions –

- (a) the vehicles which may be left in the parking place, during the hours of operation shall be vehicles displaying a valid parking permit bearing the identifying letter "E";
- (b) provide residents' parking permits for residents of the said properties, which will allow them to park in the said on-street permit holders' only parking places during the hours of operation. Such permits, which will be issued by the Council or its agents, will cost £50, for the first permit and £75 for any subsequent permit and will be valid for a period of twelve months. The charge for a duplicate permit or a change of permit due to the change of vehicle, will be £15;
- (c) provide that such residents parking permits shall be allocated using the following calculation: the sum of the number of vehicles registered to the place of abode minus the number of off-street parking places for such place of abode;
- (d) provide for:
 - (i) residents to purchase permits for use by their visitors at a cost of £2 each, which will be valid for one day, subject to a limit of 120 per year;
 - (ii) Operational Permits, for use by doctors and nurses, who are required to make visits to residents, which will be free of charge; and
 - (iii) Carer's Permits, for carers and community care personnel, who are required to make visits to housebound residents at a cost of £10
 - which will allow them to park in the said parking place;
- (e) such provisions as in sub-paragraphs 2(a)(iii), 2(a)(iv) and 2(a)(v) shall also apply.

5. "The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Tandridge) (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) (No. 1) Order 2008 (Amendment No. 10) Order 202-" which will amend "The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Tandridge) (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) (No. 1) Order 2008" so as to prohibit the stopping of vehicles outside schools, as indicated by zig-zag markings on site, in a certain length of **Holland Road, Hurst Green**, applying Monday to Friday (inclusive) applying between 8.15am-9.15am and 2.30pm-4pm. The usual exemptions shall apply, namely any person causing a vehicle to stop in order to avoid an accident if required to do so by law; anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or in accordance with a sign placed by Surrey Police in accordance with Section 66 or 67 of the Act; or any vehicle which is displaying a valid waiver certificate issued by the Council.
6. "The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Tandridge) (Disabled Residents' Free On-Street Parking Places) Order 202-" so as to –
 - (a) provide such free disabled resident's on-street parking place in a length of **New Farthingdale, Dormansland**, operating 24 hours per day;
 - (b) the letter identifier of such parking place will be "TD01";
 - (c) the resident of property No. 18 New Farthingdale will be eligible to apply for a disabled resident parking permit which will allow them to park in the said on-street parking place. Such permit, which will be issued by the Council or its agents, will be issued free of charge and will be valid for a period of twelve months;
 - (d) Such provisions as specified in sub-paragraph 2(a)(iv) shall also apply.
7. Where a new restriction is proposed in this Notice, any existing restriction on the same length of road shall be revoked.
8. "The Surrey County Council (Various Lay-Bys in Tandridge and Westway (D1399) Caterham on the Hill) (Free On-Street Parking Places) Order 2006 (Amendment No. 11) Order 202-" is also proposed, the effect of which is to make legal drafting amendments to "The Surrey County Council (Various Lay-Bys in Tandridge and Westway (D1399) Caterham on the Hill) (Free On-Street

Parking Places) Order 2006” which will not affect the operation of the prohibition and restriction on the ground.
