

**Surrey County Council**  
**Amendments to Waiting and Loading Restrictions**  
**And On-Street Parking Places in The Borough of Woking**

Surrey County Council propose to make the following Orders pursuant to Sections 1, 2, 4, 14, 32, 35, 36 and 45 to 53 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984: -

**1.** The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Woking) (Amendment of Waiting Loading and Unloading Prohibition and On-Street Parking Places Orders) (Amendment No. 3) Order 202-. The purpose and effect of which is to amend the following Orders: -

**(1)** The Surrey County Council Woking Controlled Parking Zone (Revocation and Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) Order 2019; **(2)** The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Woking) (Revocation and Consolidation of Waiting Loading and Unloading Prohibition and Restriction) Order 2019; **(3)** The Surrey County Council West Byfleet Controlled Parking Zone in the Borough of Woking (Revocation and Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) Order 2019; **(4)** The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Woking) (Consolidation and Revocation of Free Street Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) Order 2019; **(5)** The Surrey County Council Various Roads in the Borough of Woking (Residents' On-Street Parking Places) Order 2019; so as to: -

- (a)** Prohibit waiting by vehicles in certain lengths of the roads specified in the First Schedule to this Notice, on the days and at the times indicated in the said Schedule;
- (b)** Exemptions for loading on and unloading from vehicles, boarding and alighting from vehicles, using vehicles for works on or adjoining the lengths of roads referred to in the First Schedule, the maintenance of those roads and the services in them and for disabled persons' vehicles in accordance with the Blue Badge Scheme, will apply to the afore-mentioned restrictions;
- (c)** Provide that there be a restriction from loading on and unloading from vehicles in certain lengths of College Road and Maybury Hill, Woking, at any time, subject to the usual exceptions, e. g. for works on or adjoining the said lengths of roads, the maintenance of those roads and the services in them and for emergency service vehicles etc.;
- (d)** Provide such dual use voucher/permit parking places in certain lengths of the roads as are specified in the Second Schedule to this Notice; for use at the times and on the days specified in the said Schedule, for use by such vehicles for which the appropriate charge is paid or valid permit holders for appropriate area within the Woking Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ);
- (e)** Provide that vehicles left by specified disabled persons may wait in the on-street parking places referred to above, at all times without time limit;
- (f)** Provide disabled persons' parking places in certain lengths of the roads specified in the Third Schedule to this Notice operational at all times without limit of time; and to revoke a disabled persons' parking place in Eve Road, Woking;

- (g)** Provide that certain other vehicles may wait in the on-street parking places described above in certain circumstances e.g. to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes), etc. and that outside the hours of operation indicated, any vehicle may be left in any of those on-street parking places for any period without time limit;
- (h)** Introduce an on-street residents' only parking place (permit parking zone) in Eve Road and Arnold Road (part), to operate Monday-Saturday 8.30am-6pm, which will be indicated by upright signs at the terminal points and exclude areas marked with yellow lines (subject to the exemptions contained in paragraphs (e) and (g) above). The residents that may apply for parking permits for such residents' parking place will be residential addresses in Monument Road, 1-11, 15-39 and 41-53 inclusive; Arnold Road 1-85 inclusive; and Eve Road 1-71 inclusive;
- (i)** Introduce on-street residents' only parking places in High Road, Byfleet, to operate Monday-Saturday 8.30am-6pm (subject to the exemptions contained in paragraphs (e) and (g) above). The residents that may apply for parking permits for such residents' parking place will be all residential addresses in 137-143 and 147-153a High Road (inclusive);
- (j)** The conditions for the allocation of such permits referred to herein shall be - residents' permits will be issued by Woking Borough Council and will cost £50, for the first permit and £75 for any subsequent permit and will be valid for a period for twelve months. Such permits shall be allocated using the following calculation: the sum of the number of vehicles registered to the place of abode minus the number of off-street parking places for such place of abode. The charge for a duplicate permit or a change of permit due to the change of vehicle, will be £15. Permits may also be provided to carers who are required to make visits to residents at a cost of £10;; There is also provision for (1) residents to purchase permits for use by their visitors at a cost of £2 each, which will be valid for one day, subject to a limit of 120 per year (subject to the Council's discretion); and (2) operational permits, for use by doctors, nurses and community care personnel, who are required to make visits to residents, which will be free of charge, and (3) carer's permits, for carers who are required to make visits to housebound residents, which will cost £10; Business permits issued on the same criteria as residents' permits will be available for the scheme referred to in paragraph (h) herein, at a cost of £150;
- (k)** Make a drafting amendment to the Lych Way, Horsell, permit scheme so that the permit parking area shall apply to the whole highway therein;
- (l)** Amend the Surrey County Council Various Roads in Byfleet and Weybridge Temporary Prohibition of Waiting Order 2020, so as to replace the existing temporary waiting restrictions in parts of Sopwith Drive, Parvis Road and Viscount Gardens, Byfleet and made permanent;
- (m)** Where a restriction is proposed herein any existing restriction on the same length of road will be revoked, unless otherwise indicated.
- (n)** Certain drafting amendments are proposed to **(1)** The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Woking) (Consolidation of Free Street Parking Places and Revocation) Order 2019; **(2)** The Surrey County Council Brookwood

Controlled Parking Zone in the Borough of Woking (Revocation and Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) Order 2019; **(3)** The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in the Borough of Woking) (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) Order 2019; **(4)** The Surrey County Council (Borough of Woking) Free On-Street Parking Places (Police Vehicles) Order 2019; **(5)** The Surrey County Council (Borough of Woking) (Bus Parking Places and Revocation) Order 2019; **(6)** The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Woking) (Consolidation of Loading bays and Revocation) Order 2019; **(7)** The Surrey County Council Various Roads in the Borough of Woking (On-Street Car Club Parking Places) Order 2019; which will not affect the operation of the prohibitions and restrictions therein on the ground.

**2.** The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Woking) Electric Vehicle Parking Places Order 202-, which will **(a)** Introduce such electric vehicle on-street parking places in certain lengths of the roads specified in the Fourth Schedule to this Notice, to be used at the times and on the days specified therein by electric vehicles or hybrid vehicles for the purpose of charging the said vehicle by use of the electric charging post installed in respect of that parking place; **(b)** Certain other vehicles may wait in such parking places in certain circumstances e.g. to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes) to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes), etc. but no exemption shall apply to blue badge holders.
