Daily Youth Housing Advice ~ for Quadrant Assessment Teams

Book in if you're supporting a young person who is:

- Homeless, with nowhere to stay tonight
- Threatened with homelessness, e.g. relationships are breaking down at home

Note: Those young people at higher risk of homelessness include:

- Those with low school attendance/ exclusion
- Involvement in Criminal Justice System
- Missing for one night or more
- Neglect
- Substance misuse
- Domestic Abuse in the family home
- Mental health issues in the family – young person and/or parents
