**Malthouse Lane (C31) Hambledon**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021**

On 14 July 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Malthouse Lane (C31) Hambledon as extends from its junction with the access to “Hambledon Village Hall” to a point approximately 60 metres south westwards along (C31) Malthouse Lane.

The alternative route will be via Malthouse Lane; Lane End; (A283) Petworth Road; A286 Church Road; Station Lane; Hambledon Lane; and Rock Hill or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to allow critical water mains repair works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Morrisons Utility Services within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 days between the hours of 8am and 5pm within the 12 month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 26 July 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for residents, the emergency services, pedestrians, and dismantled cyclists will be maintained at all times, all other traffic will be required to follow the signed diversion route.
