**The Surrey County Council**  
**Cromwell Road (A25) Redhill**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021**

On 21 July 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Cromwell Road (A25) Redhill as extends from its junction with (D1264) Huntingdon Road to the western kerb line of its junction with the exit from “The Belfry Shopping Centre” Car Park.

The alternative route will be via A25 St Matthews Road / Station Road / Queensway / London Road; A23 Princess Way / Marketfield Way; and A25 High Street.

The Order is required to facilitate tower crane removal works to be carried out by, or on behalf of J&G Traffic Ltd within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 2 days between the hours of 6am and 8pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 31 July 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Due to the nature of the works access will only be maintained for residents within the closure area. All other traffic will be required to follow the signed diversion route.
