Crawley Ridge (D3509) Camberley
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 31 August 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Crawley Ridge (D3509) Camberley as extends from its junction with its junction with (D3525) Crawley Hill to its north eastern junction with (X3509) Crawley Drive.

Alternative Route – Crawley Ridge; A325 Portsmouth Road; and Crawley Hill or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to allow gas mains replacement works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Mole Direct Ltd within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 weeks between the hours of 8am and 6pm within the 12 month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 13 September 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. All other traffic including residents and the emergency services will be required to use the signed diversion route. No sole access will be affected.
