**The Surrey County Council**  
**Station Road (B2129) Bramley**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021**

On 28 July 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Station Road (B2129) Bramley as extends from its junction with (D937) Hall Road to its junction with (D679) Edencroft.

The alternative route will be via Station Road; The Street; Wonersh Common; A248 Kings Road; A281 Horsham Road; and Station Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate new mains electrical connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of ALS Civil within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 10 days between the hours of 8am and 6pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 04 August 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for residents within the closure area, the emergency services, pedestrians, and cyclists will be maintained at all times.
