**The Surrey County Council**  
**Bluehouse Lane (C81) Oxted**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021**

On 13 October 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Bluehouse Lane (C81) Oxted that is crossed by the rail over road bridge known as “Bluehouse Lane Railway Bridge” and for a distance of 10 metres either side.

Alternative Routes – Bluehouse Lane; Station Road East; Snatts Hill; A25 East Hill; East Hill Road; and Church Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate railway bridge examination works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Centurion Traffic Management and Network Rail within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 night between the hours of 10pm and 6am within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 22 October 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for the Emergency Services will be maintained at all times. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be provided by Marshalls if required. All other traffic will be required to follow the diversion routes listed above.
