Brighton Road (A217) Kingswood
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 01 December 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of the northbound carriageway of Brighton Road (A217) Kingswood as extends from its junction at the Tadworth Roundabout with (B2220) Tadworth Street; (B2032) Dorking Road; and (B2032) Bonsor Drive to its junction with (D1106) Shelveys Way.

Alternative Route – A217 Brighton Road (Southbound)/Reigate Hill/London Road; A25 Castlefield Road/Church Street/High Street/West Street/Buckland Road/Reigate Road; A24 Deepdene Avenue/London Road/Mickleham By-Pass/London Road/By-Pass Road/Leatherhead Road/The Street/Epsom Road/Dorking Road/South Street/High Street; A2022 Upper High Street/Alexandra Road/College Road; A240 Reigate Road; and A217 Brighton Road.

The Order is required to facilitate telecoms upgrade works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Centurion Traffic Management within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 5 days between the hours of 8pm and 6am within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 06 December 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for the emergency services, pedestrians and cyclists will be maintained at all times.
