Blackmore Crescent (D3668) and Bentham Avenue (D3669) Sheerwater
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 17 November 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of –

- (a) Blackmore Crescent (D3668) Sheerwater as extends from a point in line with the south eastern boundary of No.39 Blackmore Crescent to a point in line with the north western boundary of No.25 Blackmore Crescent; and
- (b) Bentham Avenue (D3669) Sheerwater as extends from its junction with (D3668) Blackmore Crescent north eastwards for a distance of approximately 20 metres.

Alternative Route – Blackmore Crescent; Albert Drive; Bateson Way; and Blackmore Crescent or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate new pvc water main installation works to be carried out by, or on behalf of The Clancy Group within the lengths of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 months between the hours of 7.30am and 5pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 22 November 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists. All other traffic will be required to follow the diversion routes listed above.
