**Church Hill (D447) Tatsfield**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022**

On 09 February 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to (a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Church Hill (D447) Tatsfield from a point in line with the northern boundary of the property known as "Church Farm" to a point approximately 50 metres south along (D446) Church Hill.

Alternative Route – Church Hill; Ship Hill; Tatsfield Approach Road; Clarks Lane; and Church Hill or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to allow mains water valve replacement works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Morrison Utility Services within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 4 days between the hours of 8am and 5pm within the 12 month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 18 February 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access for residents and the emergency services will be via the diversion route
