Lower Weybourne Lane (C121) Farnham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 16 March 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Lower Weybourne Lane (C121) Farnham as extends from its junction with (D5341) Green Lane to its junction with (D5342) Glorney Mead.

Alternative Route – Lower Weybourne Lane; Weybourne Road; Voxalls Lane; Lower Farnham Road; Badshot Lea Road; and Lower Weybourne Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate steelwork repairs to the railway bridge to be carried out by, or on behalf of Dyer and Butler within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 2 days between the hours of 1.30am Sunday 20 March 2022 and 4am Monday 21 March 2022 within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 20 March 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists.
