The Green (C47) Ewhurst
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 30 March 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of The Green (C47) Ewhurst as extends from its junction with (B2127) The Street/Cranleigh Road to its junction with (D276) Gadbridge Lane. Alternative Route – The Green; Somersbury Lane; Horsham Road; Ewhurst Road; Bookhurst Road; and Cranleigh Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to allow mains utility service connection and/or construction related works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Lenmark Construction Ltd within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 10 days between the hours of 8am and 4pm within the 12-month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 04 April 2022. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times, vehicular access for residents will be maintained when safe to do so, access for the emergency services will be maintained via Gadbridge Lane in an emergency situation.

The Council are satisfied that, in accordance with Section 3(2)(a) and 3(2)(b) of the Act, vehicular access to and from premises within the length of road above or accessible only therefrom may be restricted in order to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road and/or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
