Pitland Street (D280) Holmbury St Mary
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 04 May 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Pitland Street (D280) Holmbury St Mary as extends from its junction with (B2126) Horsham Road to its junction with (D280) Pitland Street in the vicinity of Rose Cottage.

Alternative Route – Horsham Road; Holmbury Hill Road; and Pitland Street or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate electrical connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of UK Power Networks within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 6 days between the hours of 8am and 5pm within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 09 May 2022. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will operate only when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained when safe to do so, if necessary, via the diversion route, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists.
