Well Farm Road (D1389) Warlingham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 04 May 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in the entire length of Well Farm Road (D1389) Warlingham. There is no applicable diversion route.

The Order is required to allow new mains water connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of SES Water within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 days between the hours of 8am and 5pm within the 12-month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 02 May 2022. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access for pedestrians will be maintained at all times. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained when safe to do so via road plates. During certain phases of the works, vehicular access to premises may be restricted, when this is the case such restriction of access will apply for no more than eight hours within any 24-hour period.
