Lonesome Lane (D334) Reigate
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 18 May 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Lonesome Lane (D334) Reigate as extends from its junction with (D1297) Ashdown Road to its junction with (D335) Lodge Lane.

Alternative Route - Lonesome Lane; Meath Green Lane; Lee Street; Vicarage Lane; A23 Brighton Road; A217 Reigate Road/Dovers Green Road; and Lonesome Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate overhead utility cabling works and/or arboriculture works and/or excavation for underground utility works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 16 days between the hours of 8am and 6pm within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 23 May 2022. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will operate only when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists. All other traffic will be required to use the signed diversion routes.
