**Hampton Court Way (A309) Thames Ditton**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022**

On 10 August 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Hampton Court Way (A309) Thames Ditton as extends from its junction with (C160) Summer Road to its junction at the roundabout with (B364) Embercourt Road.

Alternative Routes: Northbound - A307 Portsmouth Road/High Street/Kingston Hall Road/Wheatfield Way/Clarence Street; and A308 Wood Street/Horse Fair/Hampton Court Road; and Southbound - A308 Hampton Court Road/Horse Fair/Wood Street/Sopwith Way; and A307 Cromwell Road/Queen Elizabeth Road/Fairfield North/Wheatfield Way/Kingston Hall Road/High Street/Portsmouth Road.

This Order, which will commence on 15 August 2022 for a period of 18 months is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said roads, to be carried out by or on behalf of Surrey County Council, including but not limited to: pedestrian refuge installation and/or highway improvement and/or highway maintenance works. Advanced warning signs will be displayed; and the temporary closures and suspensions will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Any vehicle found to be obstructing the highway during these works will be removed to outside the limits of the works after all reasonable methods have been undertaken to identify and contact the vehicle's owner.

Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times, as will access for emergency service vehicles in an emergency situation only. Vehicular access for residents and businesses will be maintained only when safe to do so, if necessary, via the diversion route. During certain phases of the works, vehicular access to premises may be restricted, when this is the case such restriction of access will apply for no more than eight hours within any 24-hour period.
