
Meeting Title: Surrey People's Group

August SPG - Party Planning












- The group were asked what they would like to include if we made our August Surrey People's Group a party

- The group were also asked if they would prefer a party to be on a week day or a weekend. The group voted to all know the date of the party in advance




Joint Strategic Needs Assessment ether for learning disabilities and autism





- Presentation was read to the group and printed easy read version were handed between groups.
- Would focus groups be helpful. Members voted
 - -yes, and an in person meeting-small groups



- -Individual stories of experiences
- -Personal care is poor in hospitals, pads not being changed regularly enough -If relatives are not there then personal care for individuals are poor. Nail cutting, hair, pads etc.
- -A&E ask too many questions
- What could Surrey do to better your health care experience
 - -Shorter waiting lists
 - -More GP's
 - -Acute liaison nurse be more available
 - -Too many numbers to phone
 - -Dental services need to be reviewed and made better for people with LD. No provision for people with LD. Not taking on new patients.
- What has been your experience with phoning services when you have a health concern? Did you have good experiences?















- -A member fed back that they had to wait ad outsom long time in A&E and anxiety levels were high, they were tired and couldn't understand what was being asked of them especially as unwell.
- -Feedback from a member that they had a positive walk in session experience that had a good out of hours service.
- Who would you talk to if you had a health concern or didn't feel well?
 - -Staff/key worker
 - -Family
 - -GP practice
 - -Call 111
 - -Emergency services if very unwell
