Angel Road (D6810) Thames Ditton
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 23 November 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding that length of Angel Road (D6810) Thames Ditton as extends from a point in line with the southern boundary of No.92 Angel Road to its junction with the access to No.94 Angel Road.

Alternative Route – Angel Road; Sugden Road; Ewell Road; Thorkhill Road; A307 Portsmouth Road; and Angel Road or this same route in reverse.

This 12-month Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 04 December 2022 is required to facilitate bridge examination works and/or general maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Network Rail and/or Dyer and Butler within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out as soon as possible over 1 day between the hours of 7am and 5pm. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will operate only when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access for cyclists and pedestrians will be maintained at all times. Due to the nature of the works vehicular access through the site will not be possible whilst works are in progress and all vehicular traffic will be required to use the signed diversion route. No sole access will be affected by this closure.
