### **The Surrey County Council**

#### **D4017 High View Road, Guildford and B2039 Ockham Road South, East Horsley Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022**

On 19 October 2022 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit all traffic (including pedestrians and cyclists) from entering or proceeding in that length of: -

- a) D4017 High View Road, Guildford that extends from its junction with A31 Farnham Road, for a distance of 50m.

Alternative route: - D4017 Manor Way, D4017 Litchfield Way, D4018 Curling Vale, D4018 Friars Gate and A31 Farnham Road.

- b) B2039 Ockham Road South, East Horsley that extends from its junction with Old Rectory Lane, to its junction with Park Corner Drive.

Alternative route: - B2039 Ockham Road South, A246 Epsom Road, A247 The Street, A247 Clandon Road, B2215 Portsmouth Road, B2039 Ockham Road North (15' height restriction) and B2039 Ockham Road South.

This Temporary Traffic Order is required to enable Surrey County Council to carry out carriageway resurfacing and/or highway improvement and/or maintenance works. These works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 7am and 5pm, as soon as possible within the 18 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 03 November 2022. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closures which are each anticipated to be required for 2-7 days, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access for emergency services, cyclists and equestrians will be maintained at all times. Access for residents and businesses will be maintained via the diversion routes described above.

In the event that it is necessary to restrict any access at any time under Section 3 of the Act, the roads can only be closed for a maximum of 8 hours in any 24-hour period. Any vehicle found to be obstructing the highway during these works will be removed to a suitable location outside the limits of the works after all reasonable methods have been undertaken to identify and contact the vehicle's owner.
