**D5427 Lower South Street, Godalming**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023**

On 01 February 2023 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit all traffic (including pedestrians and cyclists) from entering or proceeding in that length of D5427 Lower South Street, Godalming that extends from its junction with D5438 High Street, Godalming, to the south-western property boundary of "Bishops House". This Traffic Order is required to enable Cappagh Contractors to carry out excavations and/or utility and/or rebuilding and/or maintenance works. These works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 8am and 5pm, within 12 days of the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 06 February 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for emergency services, residents and businesses will be maintained at all times. Access for pedestrians will be maintained via the footway to Godalming High Street, Flambard Way and Lower South Street. Access for cyclists and equestrians will be maintained via the alternative route:  
- Godalming High Street, Flambard Way and Lower South Street.
