D42 Old Chertsey Road, Chobham and
D21 Burnt Pollard Lane, Lightwater
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 07 March 2023 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of: - **a)** D42 Old Chertsey Road, Chobham that extends from its western junction with A319 Chertsey Road, to its junction with D42 Stonehill Road. Alternative route:– Old Chertsey Road, Chertsey Road. **b)** D21 Burnt Pollard Lane, Lightwater that is carried by the “Hook Mill Bridge” and for a distance of 10m either side. Alternative route:– Northbound – Blackstroud Lane East, Windlesham Road, Bagshot Road, A322, Guildford Road, Broadway Road, Hook Mill Lane and Burnt Pollard Lane. Southbound – Hook Mill Lane, Broadway Road, Guildford Road, A322, Bagshot Road, Windlesham Road, Blackstroud Lane East and Burnt Pollard Lane. This Traffic Order is required to facilitate Surrey County Council to carry out bridge inspections to the “Fishpool Bridge” and “Hook Mill Bridge” and/or carriageway resurfacing and/or maintenance works. These works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 8am and 5pm within two days of the 18 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 16 March 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closures will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for emergency services, residents, businesses, pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians will be maintained at all times. Any vehicle found to be obstructing the highway during these works will be removed to a suitable location outside the limits of the works after all reasonable methods have been undertaken to identify and contact the vehicle's owner.
