Notice The Surrey County Council B2032 Station Road, Betchworth Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 15 March 2023 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to prohibit all traffic (including pedestrians) from entering or proceeding in that length of B2032 Station Road. Betchworth that is crossed by the level crossing and for a distance of 10m either side. This Temporary Traffic Order is required on behalf of Network Rail to allow for digging of wet beds and/or inspections and/or maintenance works at the level crossing. These works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 8pm and 4am within 1 night of the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 26 March 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times under direction of a marshal. Access for emergency vehicles, residents, businesses and equestrians will be maintained via the vehicular diversion route: Northbound vehicular traffic will be diverted via Pebble Hill Road, Dorking Road, Brighton Road, Reigate Hill, London Road, Castlefield Road, Church Street, High Street, West Street, Buckland Road, Reigate Road and Station Road. Southbound vehicular traffic will be diverted via Station Road, Reigate Road, Buckland Road, West Street, London Road, Reigate Hill, Brighton Road, Dorking Road and Pebble Hill Road.
