

How do I search for an address?

- From the drop down arrow select whether you want to search by postcode or a named location
- You can search by:
 - Area name
 - Street name and town
 - Postcode



How do I zoom in and out?


- Use the '+' and '-' symbols to zoom in and out
- Alternatively hold the shift key and draw a box around the area you wish to zoom into
- The home symbol will reset the map to its original view



How do I view the legend?

- To see the legend, click on the legend icon on the toolbar
- The legend window should appear showing the key






How do I change the basemap?

- Click on the basemap icon
- The basemap gallery window should appear, showing different basemaps to chose from
- Note that some basemaps won't show on the map as they use a different coordinate system







How do I measure areas or distances?

- Click on the measure icon
- The measure window should appear where you can change units of measurement
- Measure distances or areas by selecting points on the map
- Double click to finish a line or shape








How do I find out more?

- Click the details icon on the tool bar
- The details window will appear with further information
- This will also link you back to the local cycling plan webpages






How do I share the map?

- Click on the share icon
- The share window should appear
- By ticking 'share current map extent' the link becomes the view of the map as you see it






How do I find my district or borough?

- Click on the bookmark icon
- The bookmark window should appear
- Click on the district or borough to zoom to it on the map





How do I print my map?

- To print the map extent you are viewing click on the print icon on the toolbar
- In the print window add a title using the 'Add custom title field' and tick to add the legend
- Click print then a link to your printout will appear
